NOTES

- (1) Any person undertaking any building operations or work of engineering construction to which the Factories Ordinance, 1946, applies must not later than seven days after the beginning thereof serve written notice on the Inspector for the District: Provided that such notice need not be sent where either:
 - (a) There are reasonable grounds for believing that such works or operations will be completed in a period less than six weeks or
 - (b) Notice has already been given in respect of works operations in progress in the same place or site.

- (2) Failure to send the required notice is an offence punishable by a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars.
